Goals and objectives

- Goal (general objective):
 - Increased capacity of higher education to support and scale digital transformation in Eastern Africa, with the aim to ensure rehabilitation services for all
- Specific objectives:
 - Strengthened role of higher education in the promotion of digital rehabilitation, including innovation and business ecosystems, in Kenya, Tanzania and Rwanda.
 - Enhanced pedagogical opportunities and increased quality of education related to digital rehabilitation in social, health and education sectors.





Action plan

- The project time is 36 months, starting from 1.3.2023 and ending 28.2.2026
- The work plan of the project consists of six (6) Work Packages (WPs)
- WP1 is managerial WP led by the project coordinator (Jamk) and the project manager. The aim is to ensure high quality management, coordination and follow-up of project activities in cooperation with the project partners.

- WP2 Digital Rehabilitation Innovation Community (UR)
 - to develop a regional Innovation Community which function as education and learning platforms enhancing the cooperation between rehabilitation education and the business sector.




- WP4 Curricula in Digital Rehabilitation (Jamk)


- WP5 Dissemination (JKUAT)

 - Competence-based framework for Digital Rehabilitation (WP4)
